The launch of the Oneonta, Saturday
 afternoon, was witnessed by large assemblages
 of people, who lined the river shore and the
 boats for several squares below the building
 from whence the gunboat emerged. There
 were near 200 persons, many of them ladies,
 obtained standing room on her deck, and ran
 the risk of a ducking as she plunged into the
 river. But the launch was gracefully ac-
 complished, only about one fourth of her
 length going under water, when she floated
 as steadily as a swan, running down below
 Vine street, six squares, before a couple of
 small steamers caught her and towed her back
 to shore. The Oneonta is an exact mate of the
 Catawba, which we described at some length
 a few weeks ago. The two are now lying
 side by side below Deer Creek, where they
 will be completed as soon as possible.
