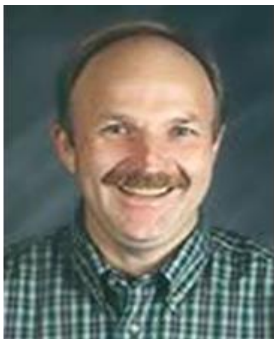

Historian Lecturer Paul LaRue *has identified over 170 names of the original WWI Veterans buried in Union Baptist Cemetery. This is by no means a complete list of WWI burials in the Union Baptist Cemetery, but a fascinating look at the diverse nature of these Veterans service and sacrifice.*
